The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on April 21, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor John Roberts, Vice Mayor Eddie Pierce and Commissioners Rick Causer, Ed LeCompte and Terry Pope. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander, and City Recorder Ruth Rohen

1. Noel Durant with Trust for Public Land gave an overview of the Stringer's Ridge Trail Extension Project. He explained that the plan is to extend the trail to White Oak Park and requested monetary assistance with the surveying cost.
2. Resolution on the agenda tonight appointing Deputy Fire Chief Brent Sylar to the Hamilton County Address Review Board.
3. Resolution on the agenda tonight to approve the purchase of a variable digital sign for City Hall, The purchase will be made utilizing donation funding from the Red Bank Soddy Daisy Charitable Foundation.
4. Resolution on the agenda tonight to amend the City's contract with Preferred Computers for IT Monitoring Services. This amendment is needed because of additional computer hardware and virus protection that the City has purchased recently.
5. Public Works Director Thornbury explained a proposed ordinance amending the Red Bank Zoning Ordinance in regard to setbacks and distance regulations in Planned Unit Developments.
6. City Manager Smith inquired if the Commissioners will be walking in the parade this year. Mayor Roberts, Vice Mayor Pierce and John Alexander will be on a team for the Moon Pie eating contest. Fire Department and Police Department will also have a team. Jimmy Turner gave an update on the 5K Hope Run and Yappy Mile.
