COMMISSIONERS AGENDA WORK SESSION

The City Commission of the City of Red Bank, Tennessee met in a public and duly advertised Agenda Work Session on April 5, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. at the Commission Chambers located at 3117 Dayton Boulevard. The date, time and location of the meeting was advertised in the Chattanooga Times Free Press, on the City's Facebook page and on the City of Red Bank website together with instructions and an internet link to enable virtual attendance by the public. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on and discuss upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor Hollie Berry, Vice Mayor Stefanie Dalton, Commissioner Ruth Jenó, Commissioner Ed LeCompte and Commissioner Pete Phillips. Also present were City Manager Martin Granum, Fire Chief Brent Sylar, Deputy Fire Chief Eddie Iles, Police Chief Dan Seymour, Public Works Director Greg Tate, Finance Director John Alexander and City Recorder Tracey Perry and City Attorney Arnold Stulce.

- I. Authorization to apply for Distracted Driving Grant in the amount of \$63,423.00 Res No. 22-1472

Chief Seymour explained the intent of the Resolution, i.e. to authorize the City to apply for the Distracted Driving grant in the amount of \$63,423.00, for the purchase of radar units, educational literature and reimbursement for officer overtime pay.

- II. Accept American Rescue Plan Act (APRA) funds in amount of \$3,513,087.40 Res No. 22-1473

Finance Director Alexander explained the intent of the Resolution, i.e. to allow the City to accept the first tranche of the APRA funds with anticipation of receiving the other half next fiscal year.

- III. Approve Erlanger and SWAT Memorandum of Understanding Res No. 22-1474

Chief Seymour explained the intent of the Resolution, i.e. to renew the agreement already in existence with Erlanger to provide medical support to the Red Bank SWAT team.

- IV. Accept Body Worn Camera Grant in the amount of \$40,000.00 with \$40,000.00 matching funds Res No. 22-1475

Chief Seymour explained the intent of the Resolution, i.e. to authorize the City to accept the Body Worn Camera Grant in the amount of \$40,000.00 with the anticipated matching amount of \$40,000.00.

- V. Any other business to discuss

Commissioner Phillips spoke on the Commissioner Retreat last Tuesday, having received the report on the Retreat, being ready to start forming the Master Plan and moving forward with digitizing the City.
