The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on March 18, 2014, at 5:00 p.m. for the purpose receiving information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor Roberts, Vice Mayor Floy Pierce and Commissioner, Eddie Pierce. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, City Recorder Ruth Rohen and those listed on Exhibit A.

1. City Manager Smith advised that the annual audit contract is on the meeting agenda tonight.
2. City Manager Smith advised that there will be a Beer Board Meeting tonight to consider an application by Carter Wexler, Big Frog Brewing Company, for a manufacture and distribution license.
3. City Manager Smith presented a draft resolution that would allow elected officials, excluding the Judge, to participate in the City's medical, dental and vision insurance program. The item will be brought up at a later agenda session.
4. Public Works Director Tim Thornbury advised that there will be ordinances to abandon the existing right-of-way on Tom Weathers Dr. and to abandon a portion of the right-of-way on Old Morrison Springs Rd. He advised that this is due to the construction of the new driveway for Red Bank Middle School.
5. City Manager Smith advised that the Public Hearing and first reading of two ordinances in regard to a rezoning request for 1918 and 1924 Dayton Blvd. is on the Commission agenda for tonight.
6. City Manager Smith advised that the City is in need of a new garbage truck. He reminded them of the deadline of 04/14/14 for the City to be able to purchase a new one under the City of East Ridge's bid. He advised that at the request of Commissioner Causer, Tim Thornbury has been checking on a refurbished garbage truck but has not received all of the information needed to report to the Commission.
7. City Manager Smith advised that the revitalization of the bridge behind City Hall is complete. He advised that the bridge is open to pedestrian traffic only.
8. City Manager Smith advised that he has received several complaints of the past week in regard to barking and vicious dogs. He has forwarded several items of information to the City Attorney for review.
9. City Manager Smith advised that Dayton Blvd. paving may be delayed until July or August due to issues with the gas company and railroad.
10. Mayor Roberts requested that the City plant flowers in the large flower pots located along the 3900 block of Dayton Blvd.
11. City Manager Smith gave an updates on efforts for the City to acquire certain properties.
