The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on March 1, 2016 at 12:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor Roberts, Vice Mayor Eddie Pierce and Commissioners Ed LeCompte and Terry Pope. Commissioner Rick Causer was absent. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander, and City Recorder Ruth Rohen. There were no citizens in attendance.

1. Public Hearing and first reading on ordinances to rezone property located at 3714 Redding Road and 2416 Lyndon Avenue in on the agenda tonight.
2. Mayor Roberts advised that the Red Bank and Soddy Daisy Charitable Foundation will be donating \$25,250.00 to the City to use towards paving a new parking lot at White Oak Park. He also advised that an anonymous donor has expressed interest in donating \$10,000.00 to the City.
3. Certificate of Compliance on the agenda tonight for Food City in regard to selling wine in grocery stores. It was explained that the actual permit will be issued through the Alcoholic Beverage Commission with the State of Tennessee.
4. Mayor Roberts discussed an article that was published in regard to Red Bank being number 3 for top suburbs for millennials. He advised that he feels the City and its officials can do a lot to counteract any negative reports by focusing on the positive things going on in Red Bank.
5. Mayor Roberts asked for the City to place a moratorium on the issuance of new permanent sign permits in the Central Business District Zone. He asked that the moratorium remain for a period of one year or until the sign ordinance can be reviewed and possibly amended.
6. The annual performance evaluation was given for City Manager Randall Smith. All Commissioners felt that he is doing a good job and that he keeps them well informed of issues concerning the City.
