The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on March 3, 2015 at 12:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor John Roberts, Vice Mayor Eddie Pierce and Commissioners Rick Causer, Ed LeCompte and Terry Pope. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Police Lieutenant Jay Lamance, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Fire Marshall Brent Sylar, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander, and City Recorder Ruth Rohen

1. City Manager Smith explained that there is a resolution on the agenda tonight to declare certain City property as surplus and authorize items to be disposed of through auction, trade or destruction.
2. City Manager Smith advised that a proposed ordinance governing temporary portable storage units was handed out in the packets this week. He requested that Commissioners forward any questions or concerns to him.
3. City Manager Smith explained that there is a proposed Senate/House bill that would eliminate the City's right to vote on proposed future local transportation projects. He encouraged the Commissioners to speak with State Representatives concerning the matter.
4. Mayor Roberts encouraged everyone to attend the upcoming FEMA open house on April 13th concerning flood maps.
5. Mayor Roberts requested that the recently approved zoning regulations be placed on the March 17th Work Session agenda for discussion.
6. Commissioner Causer advised he has received complaints from a property owner on Wickley Rd. in regard to sewage runoff from septic tanks in the area. He wanted to know the Commission feelings on partially funding an extension of the sewer system to that area.
