The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on February 3, 2015 at 12:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor John Roberts, Vice Mayor Eddie Pierce and Commissioners Rick Causer, Ed LeCompte and Terry Pope. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander, and City Recorder Ruth Rohen

1. City Manager Smith explained that the City used to be a member of the Hamilton County GIS Partnership. He gave an overview of some of the benefits of being a member and further advised that the cost of membership is \$10,000 per year. Mr. Smith recommended that for now the City continue their current procedures of contacting GIS on a case by case basis.
2. Public Hearing and request to rezone parcels located on Pinebreeze Rd. is on tonight's agenda. An adjacent property owner was present and was advised to come to the Public Hearing to voice his concerns.
3. Resolution to approve a contract with Turn-Key Mobile for the purchase of in-car video equipment is on the agenda tonight.
4. Ordinance accepting the 2014 Homeland Security Grant and to amend the budget is on the agenda tonight. \$30,000 will go towards the purchase of data tablets for the police department and \$5,000 for a mobile radio for the fire department.
5. Zoning ordinance, land use plan and zoning maps is on the agenda tonight for first reading. Commissioner Causer had several questions that were addressed by Commissioner Pope.
6. Mayor Roberts advised that the owner of an auction house has shown some interest in purchasing the old Bi-Lo property.
