The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on January 6, 2015 at 12:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor John Roberts and Commissioners Rick Causer, Ed LeCompte and Terry Pope. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander, and City Recorder Ruth Rohen

1. City manager Smith reminded the Commission that new Planning Commissioners should be appointed at the January 20th Commission Meeting.
2. Zach Welch, Lewis Wamp, Chris Scoggins, Brent Sanders, Steven Jackson and Dan McClendon requested that the City consider constructing a skateboard park within the White Oak Park facility. Commission was given handouts and allowed to ask questions. Further discussion will occur on the subject.
3. Resolution to demolish the building located at the impound lot is on the agenda tonight. Mayor Roberts advised he has been approached by a subject interested in purchasing the impound lot property and building. City Manager Smith requested that the Commission consider approving this resolution so that it will be in place in case the sale of the property does not occur.
4. Mayor Roberts advised that he would like to have the first reading on the new zoning ordinance on January 20th.
5. Resolution to approve a Revocable License Agreement with Ruth Jeno for use of the Community Center is on the agenda tonight.
6. Resolution on the agenda tonight for disposal of City owned property.
7. Finance Director Alexander explained an amendment to the FY 2015 Stormwater and State Street Aid budget. This item is on the agenda tonight.
8. Mayor Robert stated he would like to leave the vacant Detective position empty and have that position converted to an additional officer be assigned to patrol. Chief Christol explained the need for three Detectives and requested an additional patrol position.
