The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on January 5, 2016 at 12:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor Roberts, Vice Mayor Eddie Pierce and Commissioners Rick Causer, Ed LeCompte and Terry Pope. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Deputy Fire Chief Brent Sclar, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander, City Recorder Ruth Rohen, and those listed on Exhibit A.

1. Derek Markey with Fairway Outdoor Signs advised that he had requested to address the board but was present only to observe the business of the City.
2. City Manager Smith advised that Norfolk Southern has proposed closing the railroad crossing at Kildare Street and making some crossing improvements to other area crossings. He advised that this project would be completed without cost to the City. He explained that there will be a Public Hearing before any action is taken. The consensus is to move forward with the closing.
3. City Manager Smith presented renderings and a contingent plan for the placement of Pedestrian Islands that was approved for a Transportation Improvement Grant and sought direction on whether to move forward with the project. After some discussion of traffic issues and patterns, the majority of the Commission advised Mr. Smith to move forward.
4. City Manager Smith advised that he is working with Baylor School, TDOT and the City of Chattanooga to discuss traffic flow on Signal Mountain Road at Baylor School during peak hours.
5. The topic of the placement of and current city ordinance provisions related to political signs was discussed. City Manager Smith requested that the Commissioners email him with any questions, concerns or suggestions in regard to the political signs.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:36 p.m.
