The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on January 3, 2017 at 12:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor John Roberts, Vice Mayor Eddie Pierce, Commissioners Ed LeCompte, Terry Pope and Carol Rose. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander, City Recorder Ruth Rohen and those listed on Exhibit A.

1. Mayor Roberts advised that first reading of an ordinance is on the agenda tonight to rezone property located at 106 and 107 Passons Rd. from R-1 residential to C-1 commercial. He advised that this item was tabled from the December 20th Commission Meeting and that a Public Hearing was held on the matter at that meeting.
2. Mayor Roberts advised that second reading of an ordinance to amend the budget for grant funding received from the Department of Justice, Justice Assistance Grant for the purchase of radios for the police department is on the agenda tonight.
3. Mayor Roberts advised that appointments to the Red Bank Planning Commission and the Red Bank Zoning Board of Appeals are on the agenda tonight. Newly elected and re-elected officials Commissioner Carol Rose and Vice Mayor Eddie Pierce will appoint one person to each of these Boards.
4. City Manager Smith advised that there is a resolution on the agenda tonight to establish a Red Bank School District Exploratory Committee.
5. Mayor Roberts requested that City Manager Smith schedule a meeting with Representative Chuck Fleishmann to discuss the possibility of exchanging designated park land at the old middle school property for other new park land in the City. He requested that this item be placed back on the February 3, 2017 Agenda Work Session.
6. City Manager Smith gave an update on renovations to the new City Hall and the smart street lighting project.
7. Mayor Roberts advised that he was contacted by the Red Bank High School football coach who requested monetary assistance from the City of Red Bank to purchase football jerseys.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:52 p.m.
