 - (1) Signal Boxes: 16 total electrical boxes, implemented 4 phases (4 boxes per phase)

Dayton Blvd / Memorial, Dayton Blvd / Morrison Springs, Dayton Blvd / Hedgewood, Dayton Blvd / Signal Mtn Rd
Phase 2: Nature
Signal boxes near schools and Browntown Rd
 - (2) Kids Korner bathrooms: Tyler to join Parks and Rec Board meeting to ask for support. Submit RFP & invoice for \$250 design fee
 - (3) Morrison Springs Mural Project: Leslie will need to consult with a structural engineer and EPB for relighting, so this project will take place in 2025 or 2026
 - (4) Street sweeper wrap: consult with public works director Greg Tate, theme of pollution prevention

<u>CRITERIA</u> <u>Points Awarded by Board Review</u>				
<i>Relevance to Identified Theme:</i> "Our Southern Birds" (10 Points Max)				
<i>Artist Merit:</i> Consideration to include design's originality, creativity, aesthetics, and cohesiveness. (10 points Max)				

<i>Composition:</i> Does the artwork create interest? Is there a focal point? Is there a balance? Points awarded are from the evaluator's own perspective and are completely subjective. (25 Points Max)				
<i>Feasibility for Large Scale Printing:</i> Is the design suitable for high resolution printing on vinyl wrap material. (20 Points Max)				
<i>Overall Impression of Design:</i> Points awarded are from the evaluator's own opinion and are completely subjective. (10 Points Max)				
<i>Locality:</i> Is the Submitter connected to Red Bank? No = Zero Points Yes = 5 Points
