#### III NEW BUSINESS - citizens will have an opportunity to speak on these items prior to the final vote


##### A Special Event Beer Permit for David Distafano, dba Rotary Club of Chattanooga Breakfast for the Red Bank Christmas Parade on December 14, from 3-8 PM

The application and references have been reviewed and preapproved by Administration and the standard permit requirements verified by the Police Department together with the mandatory TBI background check have all been completed with no adverse findings.

Mr. Distefano was present at the Work Session on this date and explained that the Chattanooga Breakfast Rotary Club intends to sell beer at the Red Bank Christmas Parade and Festival and will mark the perimeter with signs, have security on site to check IDs, and put bracelets on those eligible to purchase beer. Vice Mayor Berry made a motion to approve the application, seconded by Commissioner Wilkinson, No discussion. No citizen comments. The application was approved with all Commissioners present voting "yes".
