A. City Park Mural pre-qualification questionnaire results– Discussion and Action

Discussion:

Megan L: I think we should get designs from both as we have budgeted for that.

Nikki: When will we get designs? When will they start?

Tessa: They will submit proposals by Jan 8th. We will vote on designs Jan 15th (and kick back with design revisions if necessary). If we propose a design revision we will discuss it on Feb 14th. City Commission meeting is on March 18th. Mural won't start until after that meeting in March.

Meghan F: Adam S's design isn't really RB oriented

Nikki: Lexi no lettering or intricate designs (facial features)

Tessa: Call to vote, progress with asking both artists for designs

Amy: move to vote

Taylor: Second

B. Grant Applications– Discussion and Action

Tessa: Parks and Rec will now cover marketing materials, but we still need to review the budget and reduce the total proposed cost

Anthony: We can bring down the band budget to \$200 for each 30 min slot and to \$120 for acoustic performers

Anthony: Also I would love to have an Improv group on the schedule and figure out they timing of everything so everything flows well

Taylor: I like having a mix of beginner and professional performers, it brings a bigger crowd
