A. Phase 1: Traffic Signal Boxes - Status update

B. Kids Corner Mural Project: Next steps

Tessa: Leslie is checking with attorney about the RFQ process as one of our qualified artist is healing from an injury. The RFQ process will be open from 2-4 weeks and ArtsBuild, AVA, and the Sunday paper will promote the RFQ. Design phase will be 1 month
