III. CONSIDERATION OF THE MINUTES

A. Public Art Citizens' Advisory Board Meeting December 18, 2024

Motion to approve: Anthony Prince, Second: Amy G, Approved unanimous

IV. NEW BUSINESS - citizens will have an opportunity to speak on these items

A. City Park Mural-Discussion and action regarding evaluations

Tessa: Adam S, concept #1 "Appalachian Sunset" totaled 676 points as the highest ranking of the concepts

Megan L: Adam used more professional design concept and utilized the doors

Anthony: Lexi's was less cohesive

Nikki: I liked Lexi's landscape concept on one wall side

Tessa: So we will move forward with Appalachian Sunset, and work now to give feedback on his concept for the mural

Megan: Will there be signage for doors?

Tessa: Also there may be a new spigot on the bathroom side? Parking side?

Anthony: the mtn scenery looks generic, isn't specific to Red Bank

Tyler: that looks more like mtn ranges in North Georgia

Taylor: I am making detailed notes on the iPad for concept feedback/corrections

Main take-aways: We all like the color palette / color scheme, but the design of the Mountain Range could be less generic (or look less like N Georgia mountains) bring the cloud variations down on some sides, Is the Design Art Deco or Native American?

Nikki: I'm bothered by the red dot on the door

Get rid of corner squares on the top of the design on all sides. Make sure corner designs align. Simplify bottom corners to align, keep white. Keep horizontal line consistent around building

#1: Courtside: don't split the leaf, just have the whole (full) leaf across doors, resolve the red dot (Don't draw too much attention to that door, it's just a storage closet)

Get rid of corner squares on top

Side note: the mountains depicted on the courtside most resemble the mountains around here

#2: Parkside: Minimize circles, no corner square on top, can keep the bottom brackets

#3: Lot Side: Delete "chopsticks" (diagonal lines), match or rescale the orange circles to that of the Parkside (minimize the circles), delete the river

#4: Parkside: Purple "windows" remove or change, simplify or mirror the yellow at the bottom of the design

B. Other Business– Discussion

Tessa: Traffic Signal boxes update: we are postponing until the fall. Leslie is asking permission to apply for a grant. We have already submitted grant proposal for the fall Arts Festival, still waiting on approval.

Taylor: the artist's list has been cleaned up, added zip code to keep things organized. Also organized grants list into a spreadsheet.

Tessa: We need a logo. Taylor and I are working on a survey to send you all soon to gather the board's input.
