The City Commission of the City of Red Bank, Tennessee met in a public and duly advertised Agenda Work Session on February 18, 2025, at 5:07 p.m. at the Commission Chambers located at 3117 Dayton Boulevard. The date, time, and location of the meeting were advertised in the Chattanooga Times Free Press, on the City's Facebook page, and on the City of Red Bank website together with instructions and an internet link to enable virtual attendance by the public and public access to the agenda and agenda items. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on and discuss upcoming business items. IV. Discuss Intent to apply for Project Diabetes Grant

Parks and Recreation Manager Grabe explained to the Commission that an application is being made to the Tennessee Department of Health for a Project Diabetes Grant with the intent to fund the Godsey Ridge trail design. This is a non-matching monthly reimbursing grant which, if approved, would potentially provide up to \$150,000.00 a year for up to three years.

V. Traffic Garden Memorandum Of Understanding with White Oak Bicycle Co-Op Res No. 25-1768

Parks and Recreation Manager Grabe explained to the Commission this Resolution is to authorize the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOD) between the City of Red Bank and White Oak Bicycle Co-op for the creation of a traffic garden on city-owned property. WOBCO will help design and paint the traffic garden on an existing paved area adjacent to Fire hall 2 and lead scheduled programming. Executive Director Blake Pierce and Director of Programming Kat Volzer of WOBCO were present and explained to the Commission that a traffic garden will provide a space for children and families to go and learn the skills necessary to be safe bicycle riders.

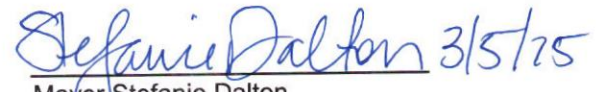
