The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on December 15, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor John Roberts, Vice Mayor Eddie Pierce and Commissioners Rick Causer, Ed LeCompte and Terry Pope. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander and City Recorder Ruth Rohen. There were no citizen attendees.

1. Chief Christol introduced TWRA Officer Joe McSpadden. Mr. McSpadden provided information in regard to coyotes in the area and certain steps that citizens can take to lessen the nuisance of the animals.
2. Finance Director Alexander presented the two findings of the FY 2015 audit. He advised that the City is implementing procedures to take care of the issues.
3. Public Works Director Tim Thornbury advised that the federal government has issued new regulations in regard to stormwater control. He explained that the regulations listed in the ordinance are the minimum standards that are required.
4. Pedestrian Island project was discussed to the extent that Wiser is reworking some of the islands and will present the drawings at a later date.
5. Public Works Director Thornbury advised that there are some size requirements located in the current political sign ordinance that are old and out of date. He explained that he will be working on revising the ordinance.
6. Don Lepard with Global Green Lighting gave an update on the street light testing that is ongoing in the City. Me. Lepard also presented an overview of new technology that his company is working on that will allow street lighting to host network programs and WIFI. He advised that he would like to partner with the City as a testing ground for these products and would like to eventually have a franchise agreement with the City.
7. Mayor Roberts advised that he, City Manager Smith and other municipal leaders had a productive meeting with Hamilton County Mayor Jim Coppinger and Senator Bo Watson about the proposed redistribution of State Shared Sales Tax..
