A. Review and Discuss: Public Art Board Logo options

B. Discuss and Action: Phase 2 Traffic Signal Boxes theme

Amy shared that "What Inspires You" is more suitable for the students, the board agreed with Amy's judgement. We are applying to the Tennessee Arts Commission for funding support for these Traffic Boxes artworks, award decision is TBD.

The Artist Directory Google Sheet was shared with the board via email, and board members were asked to **add potential artists/vendors to the spreadsheet (color-coded for easier reference) and their name for outreach when details are finalized about the festival.**

D. Follow-up: Booth sign-ups for City of Red Bank's 70th Anniversary celebration on June 21st, 2025

The Booth Sign Up Google Doc was shared with the board via email, and board members indicated their availability and involvement on the form for working shifts at the booth. At the booth, we plan to have the public art surveys to gather input for public art initiatives, Philip will bring a TV showcasing our Public Art examples and mural timelapse, and perhaps stickers with the new logo if

available to give out for survey takers.
