A. Review: Public Art Board Logo

Taylor revealed new logo stickers and handed some out to the board.

B. Follow-up: City of Red Bank's 70th Anniversary celebration on June 21st

The City has informed us that the event is 12 pm - 5 pm, not 1 pm - 5 pm as mentioned in previous meeting. The City will provide a tent/table that includes all citizen advisory boards (with 1 seat per board). We discussed shifts, as well as recommending that board members attend the 1 pm Ribbon Cutting of the new mural on the Playground Restroom building.

ACTION ITEM: Help with the Anniversary Event: info table support times scheduled and agreed to per member.

C. Follow-up: Status of Grant Applications

We didn't get the T-Mobile grant that we'd applied for to help fund the big mural on Morrison Springs Road, but we're looking at other grant and sponsorship opportunities as possibilities for funding that project. The TN Arts Commission

ABC Grant to fund four wraps for Phase 2 of the Traffic Signal Box program will be applied to soon. An additional grant opportunity with Realtor's Placemaking Grant is open for projects up to \$25,000 - we decided to apply to fund four more signal boxes for Phase 3 of the Traffic Signal Boxes program in Spring 2026. Depending on the success of finding funding sources, we'd like to consider doing a mural on the inside and outside of the Glasscock Bathroom in 2027.

D. Follow-up and Discuss: Outreach for Red Bank Arts Festival

There will be no fees charged for artists' booths. Artists within the 45-mile radius of Chattanooga are encouraged to be part of our festival (especially artists based in Red Bank). We're currently reaching out to confirm potential artist demonstrators, bands, and dancers; Tessa will reach out to the artist directory list to invite vendors, and invite community partners to share the call for vendors, too.

ACTION ITEM: All board members, please review the Artist Directory (in our shared Google Drive) by Tuesday, June 24, to update it (filling in artist/vendor emails, adding new contacts info, and other details where possible). Members should continue outreach and share the Arts Festival graphic to invite artists to be vendors.

E. Other business: Social Media

Members briefly discussed the need for social media to increase outreach and exposure. Monique expressed an interest in coordinating social media content.
