The City Commission of the City of Red Bank, Tennessee, met in a public and duly advertised Agenda Work Session on June 17, 2025, at 5:00 p.m. at the Joe Glasscock Community Center located at 3653 Tom Weathers Drive, Red Bank, TN, 37415.
