- **2. Discuss: Phase 2 Traffic Signal Boxes Student Art Project**

Phase 2 is scheduled for September through October (getting students to create designs at Red Bank Middle and High School). Then the Art Board will evaluate the top 8 designs, discuss top scoring 4 designs, and vote on finalists. After that, the Red Bank City Commission will approve the new designs to be installed and honor students at their meeting in October.

- **3. Follow-up: Status of Grant Applications**

We received the ABC Grant to cover installation for Phase 2 of the Signal Box Art Project (\$2,500)! This will be presented to the Commission on September 2 at 5 pm. Also, we have learned that the Soddy/Red Bank Foundation grant that we previously received is not time- or project-restricted.

We need to be more aware of upcoming grant opportunities to coordinate with future projects.

We discussed and voted on a rough outline of future project opportunities:

- Spring 2026: Phase 3 of Signal Box Art Project
- Summer 2026: Community Center Bathroom Mural (funding dependent)
- Fall 2026: Phase 4 of Signal Box Art Project; RB Arts Festival
- Spring 2027: Morrison Springs Mural
- Future projects: Community Mural, Food City corner, Story Walk at Godsey Ridge, Sculptures, Other Art installations at Godsey Ridge
