The City Commission of the City of Red Bank, Tennessee, met in a public and duly advertised Beer Board Meeting on September 2, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. at the Commission Chambers located at 3117 Dayton Boulevard. The date, time, and location of the meeting were advertised in the Chattanooga Times Free Press, on the City's Facebook page, and on the City of Red Bank website, together with instructions and an internet link to enable virtual attendance by the public and public access to the agenda and agenda items. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on and discuss upcoming business items. I Call to Order – Mayor Stefanie Dalton

A Daniela Paz Peterson, dba Trust for Public Land, has made an application for a Special Event Beer Permit to vend beer at a public event located at the White Oak Park, Main Pavilion, on September 15, 2025, from 4-8 PM.

Daniela Peterson was present, advised that she has read, understands, and agrees to follow the rules in the Beer Ordinance. It is an "invitation only" event. They will use wrist bands and check IDs. Vice Mayor Berry made a motion to approve, seconded by Commissioner Wilkinson. The Special Event Beer Permit for TPL's September 15 event was approved with all Commissioners voting "yes".

B Jeff Schwenke has applied for a Special Event Beer Permit for City-sponsored Food Truck Fridays, AOA Art Gala, S'mores & Sounds, and Arts Fest

Jeff Schwekne was present, advised that he has read, understands, and agrees to follow the rules in the Beer Ordinance. This permit applies to City-sponsored events only. They will use wrist bands and check IDs. Commissioner Fairbanks-Harvey made a motion to approve, seconded by Commissioner Wilkinson. The Special Event Beer Permit for Clever AleHouse at City-sponsored events was approved with all Commissioners voting "yes".
