The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on November 17, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor John Roberts, Vice Mayor Eddie Pierce and Commissioners Rick Causer, Ed LeCompte and Terry Pope. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander and City Recorder Ruth Rohen. There were no citizen attendees.

1. Wiser Consultants presented draft concepts for the installation of pedestrian islands in several locations along Dayton Blvd. Mayor Roberts suggested that Commissioners review the draft and re-visit the item during the work session on December 17th.
2. Cody Taylor with Buxton presented an overview of his company and how the company can assist the City with economic development through business recruitment and business retention strategies.
3. A Public Hearing and first reading on a rezoning request for two parcels located on Ashmore Ave. is on the Commission Agenda tonight.
4. A resolution authorizing an agreement with Total Resource Inc. for temporary labor services during leaf pick up season is on the agenda tonight.
5. City Manager Smith advised that several cell phone companies had contacted him in regard to the cell tower located at City Hall. Consensus by the Commission is to wait until closer to the expiration of the current contract to entertain new negotiations.
6. Mayor Roberts suggested that the Commissioners travel to Franklin, TN on December 11th for an economic development fact finding trip.
7. Commissioner LeCompte asked if there was any movement on the sign ordinance update or the City brochure. Item postponed until the December 1st work session for discussion.
