The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on November 15, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor John Roberts, Vice Mayor Eddie Pierce, Commissioners Rick Causer, Ed LeCompte and Terry Pope. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Police Chief Tim Christol, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander and City Recorder Ruth Rohen and those listed on Exhibit A.

1. City Manager Smith explained that there is a resolution on the agenda tonight to approve an agreement with Total Resource to provide temporary labor services during leaf pick-up season.
2. City Manager Smith advised that there are condemnation hearings for 435 and 443 Bank Street. He explained that the owners possibly sold the property but that the new and the previous owners have been notified to attend the hearing tonight.
3. Chief Christol presented information in regard to the Volkswagen Buy Back Offer. He recommended that the City sell back the seven Volkswagen Passats currently owned and to purchase Ford Interceptor SUVs to replace them. This item will be on the agenda for further consideration at a future Commission Meeting.
4. City Manager Smith explained that there has been an excessive amount of water leaking from the swimming pool. He advised that since the new liner was installed the pool is required to have full water level at all times or the liner could become damaged. After several attempts at troubleshooting the problem it was determined that the water was leaking from the main drain pipe for the swimming pool. Mr. Smith advised that he had determined that this was in the nature of an emergency and contacted Chase Reline Inc. to repair the leak at a cost of \$14,500.00. He advised that there is a resolution on the agenda tonight to ratify and approve the repair.
5. City Manager Smith invited the Commissioners to the employee Thanksgiving Potluck this Thursday between 12:00 – 1:00.
