*The City Commission of the City of Red Bank, Tennessee, met in a public and duly advertised Agenda Work Session on June 2, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. at the Commission Chambers located at 3117 Dayton Boulevard. The date, time, and location of the meeting were advertised in the Chattanooga Times Free Press, on the City's Facebook page, and on the City of Red Bank website, together with instructions and an internet link to enable virtual attendance by the public and public access to the agenda and agenda items. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on and discuss upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor Stefanie Dalton, Vice Mayor Hollie Berry, Commissioner Jamie Fairbanks-Harvey, Commissioner Terri Holmes, and Commissioner Hayes Wilkinson. Also present were City Manager Martin Granum, City Attorney Arnold Stulce, Jr., Police Chief Dan Seymour, Fire Chief Brent Sylar, Deputy Fire Chief Eddie Iles, Public Works Director Greg Tate, Chief Finance Officer Kris Pickel, City Recorder Tracey Perry, and those listed on Exhibit A.*

- I. **Employee Recognition - Assistant Fire Chief Jerry Carter - 50 years**  
Volunteer Assistant Fire Chief Jerry Carter was present and received an award for 50 years of service with the City of Red Bank.
- II. **On Consent Agenda - Approve revised GPS Policy Res No. 26-1909**  
Director Perry advised the Commission that the City Leadership Team has reviewed this policy, which has been in effect since 2013, and the only change made was to eliminate the phrase that GPS information could be used solely in a disciplinary decision.
- III. **On Consent Agenda - Approve Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) Res No. 26-1910**  
City Manager Granum did a Powerpoint presentation to explain the expenditures and revenues proposed in the Red Bank Capital Improvements Plan spreadsheet.
- IV. **On Consent Agenda - Authorize Participation in the THSO Community Traffic Safety Grant for \$98,353.70 Res No. 26-1911**  
Police Chief Seymour explained that this grant is the same one we apply for each year to offset overtime costs associated with traffic enforcement endeavors.
- V. **On Consent Agenda - Resolution Authorizing a Capital Outlay Note in the Amount of \$540,000.00, debt to be shared across various divisions of the Public Works Department Res No. 26-1912**  
Chief Finance Officer Pickel advised that this loan is for vehicles and equipment in various divisions of Public Works.
- VI. **FY26 End of Year of Grant Rollovers Ord No. 26-1309**  
Chief Finance Officer Pickel advised that this Ordinance is to appropriate funding and expenditures for grants that were not accounted for in the FY26 budget.
- VII. **FY26 End of Year Budget Amendments Ord No. 26-1310**  
Chief Finance Officer Pickel advised that this Ordinance is to appropriate funding for unexpected expenditures occurring during FY26.
- VIII. **Citizen Comments on Items on the Work Session Agenda**  
Richard Lamb, 207 Harding Rd - spoke in opposition to the tax increase and to turning Red Bank into a "15-Minute City"
