September 16, 2014
5:00 p.m.

The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on September 16, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Vice Mayor Floy Pierce, Commissioners Causer and Eddie Pierce, Mayor Roberts was absent. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander, City Recorder Ruth Rohen and those listed on Exhibit A.

1. Chief Christol introduced two new police officers, Trip Noojin and Matt Agnew.
2. City Manager Smith explained that he would like the Commission to consider increasing the purchase order limit from \$250 to \$500. He explained that it has become increasingly difficult to get three quotes for items at the \$250 limit.
3. City Manager Smith advised that the City Attorney is reviewing the current court fines and drafting an ordinance to bring them more in line with what other area city's charge.
4. Commissioners reviewed the draft animal control ordinance. Commissioner Causer recommended removing the animal licensing regulation since the City of Red Bank does not currently issue licenses.
5. City Manager Smith explained that the Regional Planning Agency has been performing certain planning reviews for the City at no charge. RPA will begin charging \$4,000 a year to perform the service. He explained after checking with Southeast Tennessee Development District it was determined that SETDD could offer the City more in-depth services. He advised he would like the Commission to consider an agreement with SETDD for these services.
6. City Manager Smith presented the bid tabulation for re-roofing City Hall. He explained that the bids were being reviewed and a recommendation will be forthcoming.
7. City Manager Smith explained that the first reading for the Growler ordinance is on the Commission Agenda tonight.
8. Commissioner Eddie Pierce advised that the principal of Red Bank Middle School invited Commissioners and employees to tour the middle school on September 23rd at 5:30.
