The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on August 18, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor John Roberts, Vice Mayor Eddie Pierce and Commissioners Rick Causer, Ed LeCompte and Terry Pope. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander and City Recorder Ruth Rohen.

1. Mayor Roberts explained that the proposed Food Truck ordinance is very extensive and requested that the item be placed on the September 1st Agenda Work Session for further discussion.
2. Distance regulations in regard to the current beer ordinance were discussed. The consensus was to have City Attorney Stulce compose draft ordinances addressing the sign ordinance and an ordinance to amend the distance regulations in the downtown business overlay zone.
3. City Manager Smith explained that there is a resolution on the Commission agenda tonight to approve the purchase of a new brush collection truck for the Solid Waste Division
4. Mayor Roberts advised that there is a resolution on the Commission Agenda tonight opposing the redistribution of State Shared Sales Taxes as proposed by Hamilton County Mayor Jim Coppinger. He advised that he has spoken with officials from other area municipalities and that they are against this redistribution also.
5. Mayor Roberts reminded the Commission of the planned trip to Atlanta to view concepts for future developments in Red Bank.
6. Mayor Roberts requested that Commissioner Causer report on any current or upcoming WWTa projects in Red Bank. Commissioner Causer explained that he will learn in October whether a grant to ease overflow issues in Red Bank will be approved.
7. Commissioner LeCompte asked if figures in regard to reinstating the Special Response Team were ready for review. Figures will be ready by the September 1st Agenda Work Session.
