The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on August 16, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor John Roberts, Vice Mayor Eddie Pierce, Commissioners Rick Causer and Ed LeCompte. Commissioner Terry Pope was absent. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, City Recorder Ruth Rohen, and Finance Director John Alexander. Also present were those listed on Exhibit A.

1. Mayor Roberts advised that the second reading on an ordinance to amend the FY 2017 budget for Transportation Improvement Projects is on the agenda tonight.
2. Mayor Roberts advised that the City is considering closing Ashmore Ave. where it turns into a one way street. City Manager Smith presented several options for the closure and was advised to proceed with Wiser Consulting to present the requisite engineering study.
3. Mayor Roberts advised that there is a Public Hearing and first reading on an ordinance to rezone property at 559 Memorial Dr. from R-1 to RZ-1 so that several single family homes in a zero lot line context and consistent with adjoining development can be constructed.
4. Police Chief Christol presented a proposal for the acquisition of 25 pieces of rapid response body armor for the police department and explained that it will cost approximately \$25,000 to do so. He explained that these will be placed over the body armor officers wear daily and offer a higher level of protection when responding to critical incident situations. The consensus was to move forward with pricing.
5. Commission members reviewed proposed corrections to the Red Bank Zoning map to correct errors included when it was adopted in February of 2015. The concept of the unintentional errors was discussed previously. Brian Taylor with Southeast Tennessee Development District was in attendance to answer questions. It was explained that there will be a Public Hearing during the Planning Commission meeting on August 18, 2016 to hear citizen input regarding the corrections and then again before final approval of the Zoning Maps by the City Commission. It was noted that the Planning Commission has already reviewed the corrections. Certified notices will also be mailed to all affected property owners.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:20 p.m.
