The Board of Commissioners met in a public and duly advertised Agenda Work Session on August 3, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. The date, time and location of the meeting were advertised in the Chattanooga Times Free Press, on the City's Facebook page and on the City of Red Bank website together with instructions and an internet link to enable virtual attendance by the public. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on and discuss upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor Hollie Berry, Vice Mayor Stefanie Dalton, Commissioner Ruth Jenó, Commissioner Ed LeCompte and Commissioner Pete Phillips. Also present were Interim City Manager John Alexander, City Attorney Arnold Stulce, Jr., City Recorder Tracey Perry, Fire Chief Brent Sylar, Deputy Fire Chief Eddie Iles, Police Chief Dan Seymour, Interim Public Works Director Greg Tate and those listed on Exhibit A.

- I. Volkert – Lullwater Bridge replacement RES NO. 21-1421
This is a Resolution for an already approved bridge replacement project allowing the City to engage Volkert to provide engineering design services for the project.
- II. Volkert – Resurfacing Dayton Blvd RES NO. 21-1422
This is a Resolution for an already approved resurfacing project of Dayton Boulevard from Browntown Road to Gadd Road allowing the City to engage Volkert to provide engineering design services for the project.
- III. Wisner – ADA Upgrades Dayton Blvd RES NO. 21-1423
This is a Resolution for an already approved ADA Upgrade project of Dayton Boulevard from East and West Newberry Street to Signal Mountain Road allowing the City to engage Wisner to provide engineering design services for the project.
- IV. Sale of Surplus Property RES NO. 21-1424
This is a Resolution allowing seized property that has been awarded to the City by the State of Tennessee and outdated equipment belonging to the City to be declared as surplus property and disposed of and/or sold.
- V. Purchase of P/U truck for PW RES NO. 21-1425
This Resolution is to allow the City to purchase a new Ford F-250 truck for the Public Works Department, for \$31,900.00, which is included in the FY22 budget.
- VI. Purchase of FD equipment and tools RES NO. 21-1426
This Resolution is to allow the City to purchase new equipment and tools for the Fire Department, for \$32,667.00, which is included in the FY22 budget.
- VII. Certified Tax Rate ORD NO. 21-1197
This Ordinance is to allow the City to deviate from the Certified Tax Rate of \$0.9923 previously suggested by the State of Tennessee and adopt a tax rate of \$1.20. Thorough discussion ensued with all Commissioners participating.
- VIII. Discussion on old Middle School Property
