The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on July 1, 2014 at 12:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor Roberts, Vice Mayor Floy Pierce, Commissioners Causer and Eddie Pierce. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander, City Recorder Ruth Rohen and those listed on Exhibit A.

1. City Manager Smith advised that the City has contracted with Hamilton County Humane Education Society for the past several years for animal control services. He explained that there is a resolution on the agenda tonight to authorize the City to renew the contract for another year.
2. City Manager Smith advised that there is a resolution on the agenda tonight authorizing a loan through TML Bond Fund. He explained that the funding is to pay for several one-time items that were discussed during the 2015 budget meetings.
3. City Manager Smith advised that there is a resolution on the agenda tonight to authorize a contract with Talley Construction, Inc. for paving of secondary roadways. He explained that the contract amount is not to exceed \$1,000,000.
4. The City will be opening bids on July 9th for the purchase of a new riding lawn mower. Resolution for approval will be the July 15th agenda.
5. City Manager Smith presented a draft ordinance in regard to alcoholic beverages in parks. Item will be discussed further at the July 15th agenda session.
6. Mayor Roberts advised that the draft of the new Zoning Regulations were reviewed by the Red Bank Planning Commission. He advised that the Planning Commission recommended approval of the new regulations. Mayor Roberts suggested that Commissioners speak with the consultant hired by Red Bank, Barry Bennett, on a one on one basis and then have further discussions.
