The City Commission of the City of Red Bank, Tennessee met in a public and duly advertised Agenda Work Session on June 21, 2022, at 5:03 p.m. at the Commission Chambers located at 3117 Dayton Boulevard. The date, time, and location of the meeting were advertised in the Chattanooga Times Free Press, on the City's Facebook page, and on the City of Red Bank website together with instructions and an internet link to enable virtual attendance by the public. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on and discuss upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor Hollie Berry, Commissioner Ruth Jenó, Commissioner Ed LeCompte, and Commissioner Pete Phillips. Also present were City Manager Martin Granum, Fire Chief Brent Sylar, Deputy Fire Chief Eddie Iles, Public Works Director Greg Tate, Finance Director John Alexander, City Recorder Tracey Perry, and City Attorney Arnold Stulce. Vice Mayor Stefanie Dalton arrived at 5:30 p.m.

- I. Purchase of Extractor Laundry Equipment Res No. 22-1487 (Brent)
Chief Brent Sylar read the intent of the Resolution, i.e., to authorize the purchase and installation of one laundry extractor at a cost of \$11,923.00 for the Fire Department using ARPA funds. Some discussion.
- II. Interlocal Agreement with HCSO Res. No. 22-1488 (Dan)
Chief Dan Seymour read the intent of the Resolution, i.e., to re-approve a three-year interlocal agreement with Hamilton County Sheriff's Office relating to Information Technology Services for the Police Department. Some discussion.
- III. Care-A-Van Adoption Res. No. 22-1489 (Tracey)
City Recorder Tracey Perry read the intent of the Resolution, i.e., to authorize the City to enter into a three-year agreement with CARTA to provide paratransit service in Red Bank funded by a transportation grant obtained by CARTA on behalf of Red Bank. Some discussion.
