The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on June 20, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor John Roberts, Vice Mayor Eddie Pierce, Commissioners Ed LeCompte, Terry Pope and Carol Rose. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Interim Police Chief John Wright, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander, and City Recorder Ruth Rohen.

1. City Manager Smith advised that the fiscal year 2018 operating budget is on the agenda tonight for second reading. He explained that the ordinance has been amended to include a 2% cost of living increase for employees. He further explained that because this is a reappraisal year, there has been clarifying verbiage added to approve a tax rate of \$1.35 per \$100 of assessed property pending receipt of the certified tax rate.
2. Mayor Roberts advised that there is a resolution on the agenda tonight to cancel the regularly scheduled commission meetings for July 4th.
3. Amendments and changes to the food truck ordinance are being reviewed by City Attorney Stulce. It was explained that the changes will be reviewed by the Planning Commission with recommendation to the City Commission.
4. Commissioner Pope advised that the recycle center is becoming increasingly busy and suggested that adding a day would be beneficial.
6. City Manager Smith provided an update of the Dayton Blvd. and Ashland Terr. box culvert repair project and the Ashland Terr. sidewalk project.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:14 p.m.
