The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on June 17, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor Roberts, Vice Mayor Floy Pierce, Commissioners Causer and Eddie Pierce. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander, City Recorder Ruth Rohen and those listed on Exhibit A.

1. City Manager Smith inquired as to if the Commission wanted to consider allowing alcoholic beverages during certain events at City owned parks. The Commissioners expressed an interest in pursuing the matter further.
2. First readings on the FY 2015 revenue and appropriations ordinances are on the agenda tonight. The second readings will be during a Special Called Commission meeting on June 18th at 12:00 p.m.
3. A resolution to amend the FY 2014 budget for year-end overages is on the agenda tonight. These amendments are for unexpected expenses that have occurred during the year.
4. An ordinance to amend the animal control ordinance is on the agenda for first reading tonight. Commissioner Causer expressed concerns about some of the language and restrictions in the ordinance.
5. Resolution to approve a construction contract for the slope repair in the 4300 block of Dayton Blvd. is on the agenda tonight.
