The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on June 6, 2017 at 12:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor John Roberts, Vice Mayor Eddie Pierce, Commissioners Ed LeCompte, Terry Pope and Carol Rose. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Interim Police John Wright, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander, and City Recorder Ruth Rohen.

1. City Manager Smith advised that there will be two condemnation hearings during the meeting tonight. Codes Enforcement Officer Dan Knight was in attendance to answer questions about the two properties to be considered.
2. City Manager Smith advised that the Public Hearing and first reading of the FY 2018 Operating Budget is on the agenda tonight.
3. Public Works Director Tim Thornbury presented photos of a wooden playground set that is comparable to the playground equipment that is currently located at Kids Corner Park and that is in need of replacement. He advised that the City will be sending out for competitive bids for the playground equipment and installation. It was noted that the new equipment will meet ADA Standards.
4. City Manager Smith advised that the current budget ordinance as presented does not include employee cost of living increases. He asked that the City Commission consider COL increases and presented several percentage option amounts. He advised that if the Commission feels that they would like to include a COL increase, the ordinance can be amended before final reading on June 20th.
5. Commissioner Pope advised that he would like to revisit the Mobile Food Unit ordinance, especially in regard to the fee schedule. City Manager Smith advised that he has been revising the ordinance and will email it to the Commissioners for review.
6. Mayor Roberts advised that he would like for the Planning Commission to review the zoning map for the City in regard to revising the maps to change the zoning for properties located along Dayton Blvd. from Meadowbrook Dr. to Barker Rd. from C-1 Commercial to O-1 Office Zone.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:27 p.m.
