June 5, 2018
12:00 p.m.

The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on June 5, 2018 at 12:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor John Roberts, Vice Mayor Eddie Pierce, Commissioners Ed LeCompte, Terry Pope and Carol Rose. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Robert Simpson, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Deputy Fire Chief Brent Sylar, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, and City Recorder Ruth Rohen.

1. Mayor Roberts advised that resident, Ben Schnell, was in attendance to address the Commission in regard to closing a city street for the purpose of having an Independence Day neighborhood block party. Mr. Schnell advised that he and some neighbors are planning a block party on July 7th. He advised that residents from Paulmar Dr., Ormand Dr., Daytona Dr., Orlando Dr. and Joyce Ave. will be invited to attend. He requested permission to close a portion of roadway on Thelma St. the runs between Ormand Dr. and Daytona Dr. Several concerns and questions in regard to insurance, alcohol, and emergency vehicle equipment access were addressed by Mr. Schnell and the Police Chief and Deputy Fire Chief. The City Manager, Police Chief, Fire Chief, Public Works Director and the City Attorney will make further study of the matter and then recommendations to the Commission.
2. Mayor Roberts advised that there is a resolution on the agenda tonight to approve an agreement in the amount of \$359,271.20 with Adams Contracting for construction of pedestrian islands at several locations within the city. He explained that 80% of the cost will be paid by a Transportation Improvement Project Grant through the State of Tennessee.
3. City Manager Smith explained that there is an ordinance on the agenda tonight to amend the current Administrative Hearing Officer ordinance to include zoning related issues to the categories of items that the Administrative Hearing Officer can hear.
4. Mayor Roberts advised that first reading of an ordinance to amend the budget for fiscal year 2018 year-end overages is on the agenda tonight.
5. Mayor Roberts advised that first reading and public hearing in regard to the fiscal year 2019 operating budget is on the agenda tonight.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:27 p.m.
