The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on June 3, 2014, at 12:00 p.m. for the purpose of receiving information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor Roberts, Vice Mayor Floy Pierce, Commissioners Causer and Eddie Pierce. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander, City Recorder Ruth Rohen and those listed on Exhibit A.

1. Joseph Koon with Retail Coach gave an overview of his company and presented information in regard to economic development.
2. Public Hearing and first reading regarding the FY 2015 budget and revenue ordinance is scheduled for tonight.
3. Beer Board meeting tonight to consider an application for Amber Busby, Rite-Aid Pharmacy, 4038 Dayton Blvd.
4. The City is receiving bids for the Dayton Blvd. slope repair project.
5. First reading on the proposed changes to the Animal Control ordinance is scheduled for tonight.
6. District 3 Commission seat appointment is on the agenda for tonight.
7. Mayor Roberts advised that the Planning Commission has been reviewing and studying the proposed revisions to the Red Bank Zoning ordinance. They plan to make their recommendation on June 13th.
8. Mayor Roberts advised that the Civil War Makers should be in place by the end of June.
9. City Manager Smith advised if any of the Commissioners plan to attend the TML Conference that they let the City Recorder know.
10. City Manager Smith advised that the City closed on the purchase of property at 3116 Elmore Ave. on May 30th and plan to close on the purchase of property at 3124 Elmore Ave. on June 4th.
11. Mayor Roberts advised that there is a petition circulating to place a referendum on the November ballot to allow wine to be sold in grocery stores.
