The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on May 17, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was to receive information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor Roberts, Vice Mayor Eddie Pierce, Commissioners Rick Causer, Ed LeCompte and Terry Pope. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Deputy Fire Chief Brent Sylar, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, City Recorder Ruth Rohen, Finance Director John Alexander and those listed on Exhibit A.

1. Commissioner Pope invited all Commissioners and Red Bank Employees to the Red Bank Swimming Pool on May 27th for their Grand Opening Celebration.
2. Resolution on the agenda tonight authorizing the Mayor to sign three Quitclaim Deeds in order to complete sales transactions of surplus real properties sold by Hamilton County during their recent back tax property sale.
3. Beer Board Hearing tonight for Big Frog Brewing Company. The owner is requesting a Craft Brewer's Sampling Permit.
4. City Manager Smith advised that the Red Bank Gators Swim Team would like to have a 5k run in conjunction with the Christmas Festival this year.
5. Chief Christol advised that the Chamber has monthly events planned at various business locations within the city. He explained that they would like to serve beer at these events. They requested that the Commission consider the possibility of issuing one Special Events Beer Permit per year to cover all events. Chief Christol explained that there would be a schedule of the events provided to the Commission before a permit was issued. City Manager Smith was instructed to consult with the City Attorney to check on this possibility.
6. The proposed 2017 operating budget was discussed.
