The Board of Commissioners met in a public and advertised Agenda Work Session on May 6, 2014, at 12:00 p.m. for the purpose receiving information on upcoming business items. Those in attendance were Mayor Roberts, Vice Mayor Floy Pierce, Commissioners Causer and Eddie Pierce. Also present were City Manager Randall Smith, Police Chief Tim Christol, Fire Chief Mark Mathews, Public Works Director Tim Thornbury, Finance Director John Alexander, City Recorder Ruth Rohen and those listed on Exhibit A.

1. Second reading on an ordinance to re-zone 238 Peace St. is on the agenda tonight.
2. Second reading to amend the beer ordinance to include a craft brewer's tasting permit is on the agenda tonight.
3. City Manager Smith advised that he will be presenting the 2015 operating budget tonight. He advised that there are several one-time purchase items that has contributed to an increase in this years budget.
4. Authorization for the City Manager to sign a Revocable License Agreement with Tara Phillips for the use of Kids Korner Pavilion to offer free yoga classes is on the agenda for tonight.
5. City Manager Smith advised that he is requesting an increase in the part time line item in the Court Department for FY 2015. This is to add an additional 8 hours per week due to an increased work load.
6. City Manager Smith advised that he received a letter from a citizen requesting that the City require a permit for erection of fences that are four feet or higher.
7. City Manager Smith advised that the City needs to replace a 1997 brush truck. He explained that the truck has been refurbished once and that one could be purchased for approximately \$125,000 off of the City of Cleveland's bid.
8. District 3 Commission Seat interviews are scheduled for May 16th beginning at 5:00 p.m. The City received five resumes and all five will be interviewed.
9. City Manager Smith gave an update on Orchard View Avenue housing complaints.
10. Mayor Roberts presented a proposed an ordinance that would amend the City Code in regard to outside storage for businesses.
11. City Manager Smith advised he is still receiving complaints about traffic hazards caused by people parking on the roadway.
12. City Manager Smith advised that City Attorney Stulce is working on strengthening the ordinance concerning dogs running at large.
